

Laird Township Board
Regular Meeting
Wednesday, November 10, 2025

Supervisor Spencer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Present were Supervisor Patricia Spencer, Treasurer Nicole Krajnak, Trustee John Juntunen, Trustee Sarah Hiltunen, and Clerk Robin Henry.

The October 8, 2025 meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Supervisor Spencer, supported by Treasurer Krajnak, to accept the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting. With all in favor, motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed. A motion was made by Trustee Juntunen and supported by Clerk Henry to accept the Treasurer's Report and authorize payment of the bills. With all in favor, motion carried.

Fire Department Report: Chief Juntunen reported that it was decided at their last meeting to pay down the balance of the fire hall loan by an additional \$10,000. Clerk Henry and Treasurer Krajnak will prepare and send the check.

Constable Report: Liquor inspection was done. There has been some theft in the township. Constable Peterson has been made aware of it.

Transfer Station Report: New security cameras are being installed. More bags are needed. Supervisor Spencer will talk to Houghton County to see if they have more available for sale at a discount.

Recreation Committee Report:

- Trunk or Treat event had approximately 60 children and 15 cars participate.
- A bake sale/pie social fundraiser for the Christmas Party will be held during the Alston Craft Fair on November 22nd. Donations are encouraged.
- In preparation for winter, the volleyball net was taken down and bases from the ballfield have been removed and are stored until spring.

Assessor's Report:

- No Board of Review is scheduled for December at this time.
- Trainings are needed for Board of Review members. These will be scheduled at a later date.

Ambulance Committee Report: R. McGahan is attending a meeting tonight. No new information was provided.

Old Business:


- Copper Shores Grant is still being discussed. TC Electric will hold his price, but is unsure when the work will be started.
